Here is some information you will need for the first few weeks of term.

PE

Nursery – Tuesday & Thursday (starts 25th Sept)

Reception – Monday & Friday (starts 14th Sept)

Year 1 – Tuesday & Friday (starts 14th Sept)

Year 2 - Tuesday and Thursday (starts 13th Sept)

(Nursery children wear their PE kits on PE days and bring uniform in PE bags to change after. Reception children do the same on Fridays only)

All children should bring a bottle of water to school (named!!). This can be refilled from the purified drinking tap.

Library

Monday is library day - for Year 1 and Year 2

Spellings

Friday is spelling day for Years 1 and 2.

Reception class will join in the spelling challenge in January!

Uniform

The school uniform shop is open on Thursday mornings, from 9-9.45am. Please make sure your child's uniform is correct and is named. We will be checking uniform next week! Letters will be sent out if uniform is incorrect. School shoes should not be trainer style.

Can I remind you that the girls who have long hair should have it tied back with plain and simple white or blue bands and bobbles, etc. Boys hair should be short. Girls with earrings should wear small gold or silver studs. No other jewellery is permitted-even for religious reasons. No nail polish is allowed.

On Tuesday, 18th September there will be an informal reading meeting at 3.40pm in the Reception classroom for Reception parents. Details to follow next week!!

There are a number of children in the Infant department who have certain food allergies. For this reason we ask that you do not provide your child with dried fruit, nuts and seeds or kiwi. Could you also please explain the importance of not sharing or swapping food at school.

On the subject of food, we encourage the children to bring healthy snacks and lunches. As a change to previous years, we ask that the children do not bring birthday cakes or sweet treats for the class.
