

Infant Department Uniform list (Nursery, Reception, Years 1 and 2)
Minimum requirements

CORRECT SCHOOL UNIFORM TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES - NO SUBSTITUTES ARE ALLOWED

Girls

3 blue and white striped dresses - from school uniform shop only
1 navy blue **school** sweatshirt
Plain white socks (plain navy blue or white tights in middle term during cold weather)
Black or navy blue leather closed toed shoes plain style (no fashion or patent)

Boys

3 plain white polo type shirts
2 pairs navy blue school dress shorts (no long trousers)
1 navy blue **school** sweatshirt
black or navy blue leather closed toed shoes
navy blue socks

P.E. Kits for both Boys and Girls

1 pair navy blue school gym shorts
1 white **school** T-shirt
white, black or navy plimsolls with soft soles or plain white trainers
All these items of P.E. kit must be brought to school in a named, school PE bag.

A **school** tracksuit and only this may be worn for extra warmth during the period from November to the end of February. However, this is not an obligatory purchase, and should be worn as an extra layer over all other uniform. The tracksuit can then be removed if the weather becomes hot.

All items of school uniform MUST be clearly named. Ink is not advisable as it washes out. A check will be made of all uniform and labels in the second week of each term. All items of school uniform except footwear should be purchased from the school uniform shop which is open from 8.45 - 9.30am on Thursday mornings.

Hair

Girls' hair should be clean and tidy and, if long, worn tied back off the face with a navy blue or white ribbon or elastic type band.
Boys' hair must be clean and SHORT
Outlandish hair styles are not permitted for girls or boys

Jewellery

Jewellery may not be worn to school because of the danger of physical injury or loss. The only exception to this rule is a watch and if absolutely necessary girls may wear a pair of very small plain stud earrings (not coloured).

All infants need a small school bag for their packed lunch, and a school drawstring bag for their P.E. Kit. Please do not buy large bags with wheels and a handle as several children have caused accidents with this type of bag. From Nursery onwards a Wingate School book bag should be purchased from Miss Pearson. Early training in dressing, undressing and putting clothes in a neat pile would be greatly appreciated.
