

Dear parents

You should have received an email from Mr Macrae informing you of the changes to our starting days in September, in the light of recent guidelines from the Government for re-opening safely. Please read the following information carefully regarding new dates and times. I will send another email at the start of September with further updates, regarding what the children need to bring to school, etc.

Thursday 10th September 9.30 am to 12.30pm (no lunch)

Friday 11th September 9.30 am to 12.30pm (no lunch)

Monday 14th September 9.30 am to 12.30pm (no lunch)

Tuesday 15th September 9.30 am to 12.30pm (no lunch)

Wednesday 16th -Friday 18th September 9.00 am to 1.30 pm (with lunch)

Monday 21st September onwards 9.00 am to 3.15pm with lunch

Please note that the first 4 days begin at 9.30am. This is to avoid the Nursery children arriving at the same time as the rest of the school and so helping them to settle quickly and feel safe and secure. At 12.30pm the children will be brought to the infant gate to meet parents.

As of Monday 14th September, a member of staff will be at the school gate to greet your child and take him/her into class. For the safety of all our students and staff, as well as a smooth start to the school year, we need to insist that parents allow the children to enter school with the help of our staff. This routine will be new to all of us (and it may feel strange waving goodbye at the school gate) but I am sure that the children (and parents) will quickly get used to it. As guidelines/rules change, of course I shall keep you informed.
