We are pleased to be able to recommence the catering service that was so popular before lockdown so that our students can continue to benefit from good nutritious hot food.

We will give even more thoughtful care and planning due to the current pandemic legislation and make sure that school lunchtime is an enjoyable and safe experience with time spent enjoying good food in the company of their peers and teachers.

We will follow strict guidelines for the catering to be provided and we will make washing hands the school mantra.

As per new government protocols, the children will have their meals delivered directly to their classrooms or designated class area so that they do not mix with any other classes. Tables and chairs that the children use for the catering service will be cleaned before and after use.

Disposable gloves, aprons and face-masks will be used by all serving staff at all times.

A specific risk assessment for managing the risk of COVID-19 transmission in the kitchen has been undertaken and the strictest measures are being taken to mitigate any risk.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- We will continue to offer a **30€ monthly discount** to all our students in an effort to support parents through these difficult times. The full price for the catering is €150.00 with a €30.00 discount = 120€/month for the whole academic year 2020/2021. The school reserves the right to modify the discount for the following academic years.
- The charge for the school meal will be added to your account on a termly basis but you can opt to pay for the meals on a monthly basis, however, payments must be made in advance.
- The school will require a 30 day notice period to remove your child from the catering service. Your child will be registered for the catering service until we are advised to the contrary.
- Any food allergies/intolerances will need to be confirmed with a doctor's note before the special menu can be provided. At least 3 days in advance.
- Special religious dietary needs can be catered for but a minimum notice of 3 days must be given.
- Pupils will only be provided with the meal that has been arranged in advance from the menu.
- Pupils will be encouraged to taste everything that is provided on the menu but they will not be forced to eat. The food monitors will provide feedback to parents on a daily basis – keeping parents totally up-to-date with their child's daily nutrition. If your child is a fussy eater, our contentious and trained staff will carefully monitor your child and do their best to encourage them to eat healthy every day and you will be informed if this is not happening.
