Primary Department Uniform list (Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6)

CORRECT SCHOOL UNIFORM TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES - NO SUBSTITUTES ALLOWED

Girls - Years 1 - 2

3 blue and white striped dresses - from school uniform shop only

1 navy blue school sweatshirt

Plain white socks (plain navy blue or white tights in middle term during cold weather)

Black or navy blue leather closed toed shoes plain style (no fashion or patent)

Boys - Years 1 - 2

3 plain white polo type shirts – not available in the school uniform shop

2 pairs navy blue school dress shorts (no long trousers)

1 navy blue school sweatshirt

Black or navy blue leather closed toed shoes

Navy blue socks

Girls - Years 3 - 6

1 Tartan Pleated skirt

3 White Polo shirts – not available in the school uniform shop

1 navy blue school sweatshirt

White socks (or navy blue tights in the cold weather during the Spring Term)

Plain black or navy blue leather shoes (no open toes, high heels, patent leather or fashion shoes)

Plain black back pack for school books and chromebook (with a separate compartment for the chromebook)

Boys - Years 3 - 6

2 pairs navy blue school shorts (no long trousers)

3 white polo type shirts – not available in the school uniform shop

1 navy blue school sweatshirt

Black or navy blue closed toed leather shoes

Navy blue socks

Plain black back pack for school books and chromebook (with a separate compartment for the chromebook)

P.E. Kit for Boys and Girls

PE Shorts

PE T Shirt

White, black or navy trainers but not boots

On days when pupils have sports they may come to school in their PE kit.

On particularly cold school days children are allowed to wear, only school tracksuits, over normal school uniform from the beginning of November to the end of February. The tracksuit (which is not an obligatory purchase) can then be removed if the weather becomes hot.

All items of school uniform MUST be named with an embroidered label (ink washes out). A check will be made of all uniform and labels in the first week of each term.
