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Terms and Conditions

- Please ensure you register your child to take part in the activity by completing the registration form.
- There is a minimum of students per activity.
- All spaces are subject to availability based on ratios. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis
- The school will require a 30 day notice period, before the end of each term, to remove your child from the

activity. A full term must be completed.

• All sessions must be paid for in advance termly, directly to school (You will be emailed an invoice for your

chosen sessions).

- Refunds on sessions that your child is unable to attend are only available upon receipt of an official medical certificate.
- Please note that failure to pay for your sessions in advance means that you forfeit your child's place in the

activity.

- Sessions will not run during school holidays or when school is closed for bank holidays.
- Please ensure your child has the appropriate clothing and footwear for their activity – incorrect clothing may result in your child not being able to participate in the activity. For outdoor activities they must apply sun cream at the end of the school day, wear a cap and refill their water bottle before commencing.
- Your child must participate demonstrating good attitude and behaviour at all times. Failure to do this means they

are at risk of being withdrawn from the activity.

• Please ensure your child is collected from the activity at the exact time they finish. If this rule is not adhered to

then a 'late pick-up charge' may be applied.

- Emergency contacts and passwords must be given before a child can attend the After School Club.
- Any child that has attended school on the day of their activities but cannot attend the after school activities must

report this to the school office before 14.00 hrs.
