

Behaviour - What will happen if you do not keep to the standards expected of all pupils at Wingate School?

WHAT IS INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT?

This is the way you act and includes

Behaviour during lessons – being disruptive, using offensive language, being disrespectful, use of phone

Out of class behaviour (during breaks, lunchtimes and in between lessons) – as above

Attendance and punctuality – regular unauthorised lateness and absences

Personal presentation – wearing incorrect school uniform, not having equipment including your chrome book

Completion of homework not completed on time or to the best of your ability

There are some occasions which may require skipping steps of the chart:

- Fighting / aggressive behaviour
- Theft
- Wilful destruction of property
- **Smoking on School property**
- Consuming alcohol in School**
- Taking, or being in possession, of illegal substances both IN and OUT of School**

You will receive a warning from the teacher.
You must try to understand what you have done wrong and not do it again.

If behaviour continues

You will have a 10-minute intervention session with your teacher.
This is a time to discuss your behaviour with the teacher and work out a plan forward.
Your tutor will be informed.

If you don't turn up to the session without a valid reason

If behaviour continues

You will have an intervention session with your form tutor.
This is a time to discuss your behaviour with your tutor and work out a plan forward.
Your parents / guardians will also be informed.

If you don't turn up to the session without a valid reason

If behaviour continues

You will have an intervention session with the Head of Seniors.
This is a time to discuss the behaviour with the Tutors and work out a plan forward.
Your parents will also be informed.

If behaviour continues

Your parents / guardians will be invited into school to discuss your behaviour.
You will be monitored through a Key Stage report system.

If the report shows your behaviour has not improved

After-school intervention session with Mr. Howells.
Put on a report for 2 weeks monitored by Mr. Howells
Parents informed

If the report shows your behaviour has still not improved, you may be suspended / expelled from Wingate School.
