

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS – SATURDAY LEARN AND PLAY 2026-2027

These Terms and Conditions form part of the contract between the student's legal representatives ("contractual partners") and Learning First British School, S.L. ("LFT"). By registering for Saturday Learn and Play, contractual partners agree to these conditions..

1. Contract and Obligations of the Contractual Partners

- a. Registration confirms acceptance of the contract and Terms & Conditions.
- b. Contractual partners are jointly responsible for all obligations arising from the agreement.
- c. Families agree to follow the academy rules, code of conduct, and handbook.
- d. The contract remains valid from registration until the student's final day of attendance.

2. Contract and Obligations of LFT

- a. The programme runs for 10 months (33 Saturdays) from 5th September 2025 to 12th June 2027.
- b. Classes are taught by qualified teachers and assistants using modern teaching methods focused on building confidence in spoken English.
- b. The course includes:
 - I. 2 hours of Cambridge English lessons.
 - II. 2 hours of project-based learning focused on listening and speaking.
- c. English is the only language used during the course.
- d. LFT hires qualified staff and ensures at least one first-aid-trained member of staff is present.
- e. Students may be placed with different teachers/classes at LFT's discretion.
- f. While we aim to help every child make excellent progress in English, specific language outcomes cannot be guaranteed.
- g. Registration and data protection forms must be completed before attendance.

3. Hours of Saturday Learn and Play

- a. Saturdays from 10:00–14:00.
- b. Students must be collected promptly at 14:00.
- c. Late collection fee: €12 per 20 minutes.

4. Saturday Learn and Play Projects

- a. Each Saturday, 2 hours are dedicated to project-based learning through creative activities that stimulate students' imagination and help them build confidence in listening and speaking English. Sports and orientation activities are also included.
- b. Each month follows a project theme, which the teacher develops with the students each Saturday. LFT decides the monthly project theme, there is no right to choose.
- c. Information about projects and activities is provided in good faith. All activities are subject to change due to weather conditions, scheduling, or other arrangements.

- d. LFT reserves the right to cancel, modify, or alter activities if unforeseen circumstances arise.

5. Snacks

- a. Students must bring a small snack and a bottle of water clearly labelled with their name.
- b. No peanuts or shellfish permitted.
- c. Students are supervised while eating.

6. Personal Belongings

- a. Students must bring a bag with a change of clothes, sunscreen, and a cap. All belongings must be clearly labelled with the student's name.
- b. Mobile phones, computers, video games, iPads, cameras, AirPods, or any other valuable electronic items are not permitted on site and must be left at home.
- c. Students should not bring toys or other valuable items to the course.
- d. LFT does not accept responsibility for the loss or damage of any student's personal property.

7. Dress Code

- a. Students must attend the Saturday Learn and Play course in comfortable clothing and footwear, such as sports shoes.
- b. Open shoes are not permitted.

8. Behaviour

- a. Students must respect staff, classmates, equipment, and facilities
- b. Dangerous, aggressive, discriminatory, or destructive behaviour may result in suspension or dismissal without refund.

9. Saturday Learn and Play Fees

- a. At the beginning of each academic year, a 100€ **non-refundable registration fee** must be paid:
- b. **First-year registration fee:**
 - i. Registration fee of 100€ for the first child.
 - ii. 20% discount on the registration fee for the second child.
 - iii. 30% discount on the registration fee for the third child.
 - iv. No registration fee charged for the fourth child.
- c. **Second year and subsequent years:**

- I. 20% discount on the registration fee for the first child.
 - II. 40% discount on the enrolment fee for the second child
 - III. 50% discount on the enrolment fee for the third child
 - IV. No enrolment fee will be charged for the fourth child
- d. A refundable deposit of 550€ at the end of the 10-month course
 - e. 10 monthly payments of €182 to be paid at the beginning of each month from September 2026 until June 2027, or 3 quarterly payments of €728, €546, and €546.
 - f. Books cost between €70 and €90 depending on the course level.
 - g. Any excursions during the Saturday Learn and Play program are not included in the fee, and there will be an additional charge depending on the excursions and transport required. This will be communicated to the contracting partners when excursions are organized.

10. Financial Provisions / Payment Conditions

- a. Registration fee is non-refundable.
- b. Deposit must be paid once accepted into the course, refundable at the end of the course
- b. Monthly/quarterly fees must be paid by bank transfer at the beginning of each month.

11. Cancellation

- a. Cancellation requires 3 months' written notice to administration@wingateschool.com.
- b. Fees remain payable during the notice period.
- c. The deposit may only be used towards cancellation fees if no balance is outstanding.
- b. No refunds are given for interruptions caused by force majeure, government restrictions, pandemics, or emergencies.

12. Extraordinary Termination of Contract by LFT

LFT may terminate the contract immediately if:

- A student seriously breaches rules.
- Behaviour endangers others.
- Terms and Conditions are breached.
- Repeated absences occur without notice.

Termination may result in administrative and cancellation fees.

13. Class Schedule, School Holidays, and Public Holidays

- a. LFT follows all national, local public and academic holidays. Please refer to the course calendar.
- b. Families will be informed of schedule changes and holidays.

14. Absences and Tardiness

- a. Families must inform LFT of absences or lateness.
- b. No refunds or make-up classes are provided for absences or lateness.

15. Insurance and Medical Assistance

- a. By signing the Saturday Learn and Play contract, contracting partners confirm that the student is insured against the consequences of accidents under statutory and/or private health insurance.
- b. Wingate/LFT provides accident insurance for students in the Saturday Learn and Play program. Contracting partners must provide insurance coverage effective in Spain, particularly liability insurance.
- c. Our staff are not trained to administer any kind of medication. If your child requires medication, we ask that it be administered by the contracting partners before arrival.

16. Liability

LFT accepts no liability towards the student or third parties, in particular in the case of accidents, losses, personal injury, property damage, or financial losses of any kind, to the extent permitted by law.

17. Additional Provisions

LFT reserves the right to cancel Saturday Learn and Play activities if there are not enough students or if other circumstances make it unreasonable for LFT to carry them out. Additionally, LFT reserves the right to make changes to project-based learning materials for important reasons, while safeguarding the legitimate interests of registered students.

18. Final Provisions

- a. If any part of this agreement is found to be legally invalid, the rest of the Terms and Conditions will still remain in effect. Any invalid section will be interpreted or replaced in a fair and lawful way that reflects the original intention of the agreement as closely as possible.
- b. Supplements and any amendments to the terms and conditions must be sent in writing (by email) by LFT to the contracting partners to become effective.
- c. Spanish law applies to all legal relationships with LFT. The place of jurisdiction is the registered office, and LFT is also entitled to take legal action against contracting partners at their place of residence.

19. Data Protection

In accordance with the Organic Law on the Protection of Personal Data and Guarantee of Digital Rights (LOPDGDD 3/2018) and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR EU 2016/679), personal data included in this document, or collected during the course of the

relationship with Learning First British School SL, will be processed solely for the provision and management of the agreed services. Personal data may only be shared with third parties where necessary for the delivery of these services or where legally required. By signing this agreement, the data subject gives consent for the processing of their personal data in accordance with current legislation.
